Hobcaw Yacht Club Boat Yard / Water Front Rules

In accordance with our Club Regulations and insurance requirements, and as a courtesy to fellow members, each member and guest must comply with the following rules concerning the boat yard.

- 1. Boating takes precedence over all other waterfront activities.
- 2. Only members and their (Escorted) guest may use the waterfront facilities.
- 3. Motor vehicle operation in the boat yard is limited to water recreational activity (i.e. launching and recovering boats). Maximum motor vehicle speed is 5 MPH.
- 4. Motor vehicles and trailers must be parked only in the center or riverside (yellow) spaces of the boatyard. Blue Parking spaces on the East side of the boatyard are reserved for paid rental spaces. Do not park to block launching ramp, or docks.
- 5. Only vehicles with trailers are allow to park in the boatyard
- 6. Please prepare your boat for use before launching. Move to the floating docks, as far as possible from the ramp, to complete preparations for getting under way.
- 7. When returning, prepare your recovery before approaching the ramp.
- 8. From April 1st, through October 31st, maximum parking time at all docks for unattended boats is;
 - a. 30 minutes on front (creek) side of docks
 - b. 3 hours on back (shore) side of docks
- 9. Boats may not be left at the dock or in the boatyard parking spots overnight without prior permission from the Boatyard Manager. Permissions will be evaluated and granted on a case-by-case basis for special circumstances.
- 10. All vehicles entering the boatyard must have a Hobcaw Yacht Club Burgee sticker on the rear window. Vehicles without this sticker may be towed at the owner's expense.
- 11. Absolutely no swimming from the boat ramps or docks.
- 12. The water area within 300 feet of the Hobcaw Yacht Club docks is a no-wake area, with a 5 MPH speed limit.
- 13. Please deposit all trash in the dumpster located in the boatyard.
- 14. When in doubt, the rules of common sense and courtesy shall apply.

These rules are for your benefit and will help prevent unwanted vandalism, theft, non-member usage and damage to our parking lot.

BOATS AND OR EQUIPMENT LEFT IN THE BOATYARD IN VIOLATION OF THESE PROCEDURES MAY BE TOWED AWAY AND OR DISPOSED OF AT THE OWNERS EXPENSE.

KEEP THE BOATYARD GATE CLOSED AT ALL TIMES! IF THE GATE IS BROKEN, PLEASE NOTIFY A BOARD MEMBER ASAP.
