1. RULES:

- 1.1 This regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 Appendix V will be in effect.
- 1.3 The 2019 NOR for the SAYRA Youth Championship for youth classes.
- 1.3 The USS prescriptions to rules 63.2 and 63.4 are deleted.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all one-design boats less than 24 feet (with the exception of E-Scows) with 3 or more boats registered.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing a registration form and payment of fees.
- 2.3 Registration forms, links to on-line registration is found at www.hycclub.org under sailing.
- 2.4 Both Spin and non-spin 420s will start together but scored separate. See SI rule 1.3.

3. FEES:

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions and course diagrams will be available at registration desk on 12 & 13 July 2019 located in the clubhouse.

6. PENALTY SYSTEM

6.1. Rules V1 and V2 of Appendix V will be elaborated in the sailing instructions. including where to go for necessary forms to be completed and to whom it should be submitted.

7. SCORING:

7.1. An unlimited number of races are scheduled on all courses. One race completed will constitute a regatta.

7.2. The regatta will be scored with the low point system as described in RRS, Appendix A as amended to read that if 5 or more races are scored, each boat will exclude her worst score

8. PRIZES:

8.1 1st – 3rd place trophies will be awarded for each class having 6 boats or more.

Awards will be handed out on Sunday.

8.2 The Michele Poulnot award for the best female sailor will be presented at the awards ceremony on Sunday.
